1) Correct usage for GPS reception-----

- For the quickest GPS signal reception, switch FineCaddie on and wait for minutes until completing to search golf courses and receiving GPS signal with grabbing FineCaddie as 'Proper instance'
- When wearing FineCaddie on the wrist band or the waist belt, please wear it after GPS reception has been completed
- Please do not use FineCaddie to put on the top or bottom of the pocket. GPS reception sensitivity could be greatly reduced



3) Start



■ Power on

① Press and hold the o Power button at the upper left of FineCaddie until the Green View screen (main screen) appears

■ Language selection (1)

- 1) Press the + Volume button to move to your desired language
- ① Press the M Menu button or D Voice button to save and quit

(2) If GPS reception does not work (indoors, etc.), the product will stand by in the "Receiving GPS" condition

If the golf course does not appear after GPS reception, the product will stand by in the "Searching for golf course" condition

4) End

■ Power off

① Press and hold the o Power button at the upper left of FineCaddie to turn off the power

5) Green View -----


■ Guide to remaining distance

① Press the 🔳 Voice button to hear information about the remaining distance to the front / center / back of the green




■ Dynamic Green View

① Depending on the user's location, while the green is rotating in real-time, precise information about the remaining distance to the front / center / back of the green



6) Hazard View / Bunker View / Driving Distance View ------



- Hazard View: Check the remaining distance to a hazard
 - Press the Menu button on the Green View screen to hear information about the remaining distance forward / hackward to hazards
- Bunker View: Check the remaining distance to the nearest bunker
 - Press the Menu button on the Hazard View screen to hear information about the remaining distance forward to the nearest left / right bunkers
- Driving Distance View : Check the driving distance measured so far
 - Press the M Menu button in the Bunker View screen to move to the driving distance measurement



7) Measuring Driving Distance -----



■ Measuring driving distance

- ① Start measuring: Press and hold the 🗐 Voice button on the Green View screen to start measuring driving distance
- ② Stop and restart measuring : Press and hold the 🔳 Voice button on the Green View screen to show the driving distance measurement and to start measuring a new driving distance

Tip: Press and hold the
Voice button on the tee box before the tee shot to start measuring driving distance.

Then just press the
Voice button at the location where the ball fell to check the driving distance of all shots.

(1) When moving to the next hole, the driving distance is automatically ended

8) Virtual round -----

■ What is Virtual round?


- FineCaddie allows the user to experience the same environment to try out a round before getting on the golf course, the user
 can experience all the features of FineCaddie in advance
- When Virtual round starts, FineCaddie shows the distance be changed on the screen in real time as the user plays an actual round of golf in a golf course(about 5 minutes)
- · Learn functions by pressing various buttons in advance
- When the user closes to the green, FineCaddie turns into the Dynamic Green View mode to show the Green View rotating in real time as the user actually moves around the green
- Set values suitable for you by changing various setting values in advance(Unit setup)

■ How to use

- ① Press and hold the M Menu button from any View screen to move to the Settings screen
- ② Move to Virtual round menu using the + Volume button Enter to Virtual round using the M Menu button
 - * When Virtual round starts, the device automatically reboots and then Virtual round starts
 When Virtual round finishes, the device automatically reboots and then Receiving GPS screen is showed



Shortcut buttons (+ - simultaneously press and hold): Press and hold both + - Volume buttons at the same time from any View screen to move automatically to the Change Pin Location screen

- ② Using the 🛨 Volume button move to the change Pin Location screen Using the M Menu button move to the related screen
- ③ Change Pin Location using the 🛨 Volume button
- ④ Press the M Menu button to save and quit Press the ■ Voice button to quit without saving





- ① Press and hold the Menu button from any View screen to move to the Menu screen
- ② Using the + volume button to move to the manual hole change menu Using the M Menu button to move to the related screen
- ③ Change to the user's desired hole using the 🛨 🖃 Volume button
- ④ Press the Menu button to save and quit Press the Voice button to quit without saving



6) Reset -----

■ While using FineCaddie, if it suddenly stops working or breaks, press the o Power button for 8 seconds and it will reboot

7) Error Code ------

- After device updates, if FineCaddie is not working properly, error code will be displayed In this case, use FineCaddie EZ downloader and retry to update
 - If the error code is displayed continually, please contact your dealer

■ Display FineCaddie's serial number, Firmware version and golf course data version



9) How to Set the Time Zone -

■ Menu

- (1) Select your Time Zone
- 2 DST(Daylight Savings Time) ON/OFF

- 1) Press and hold the M Menu button from any View screen to move to the Settings screen
- ② Using the + Volume button move to the Setting & Manual menu Using the M Menu button select to the Setting & Manual menu
- ③ Using the + Volume button move to the Time Zone menu Using the M Menu button select to the related screen(screen 1)
- 4 Change to the desired Time Zone using the Volume button
- ⑤ Press the M Menu button to save and quit Press the ■ Voice button to quit without saving

■ How to use

- ① Using the 🛨 Volume button move to GMT (Greenwich Mean Time)
- 2 Press the M Menu button to save and Move to the DST setting
- 3 Set DST ON/OFF using the + Volume button

1) How to check version information : Menu > Setting & Manual > Version



2) Install FineCaddie EZ downloader -----

- ① Please visit our website (www.fine-drive.com/en) > Product Information > GolfGPS > Club DB update
- ② Install "FineCaddie EZ downloader" on your computer to update the firmware and the golf course database.
- ③ Click on Download FineCaddie EZ downloader 1 (Click the mouse left button once).
 Unable to run execute file: Click on [Internet Explorer menu> Safety > SmartScreen Filter > Turn off SmartScreen Filter] sequentially

4 A mini window will pop up asking you, [Do you want to run or save this file?] Click on the [Run] button.




(6) A mini Installation window will pop up welcoming you to FineCaddie EZ downloader. Click on the [Next] button.



(5) A [Are you sure you want to run this software?] dialog will appear and then click on the [Run] button.



- (7) To specify your own location click on the button [Browse...] and select a location for installation.
 - Click on the [Next] button to proceed further.
- * We recommend using the default installation folder selected by FineCaddie EZ downloader.





- When the [FineCaddie EZ downloader notice] window appears on your computer just as below picture, the installation of FineCaddie EZ downloader is completed.
- * FineCaddie EZ downloader icon will display on your desktop.



3) Start Update -----

- ① EZ downloader will start automatically after turning on FineCaddie and connecting it on your computer using the USB cable.
- * Connect FineCaddie on your computer without power on, the recharging display will be appearing on the device screen.

 FineCaddie EZ downloader will get started automatically when you turning on FineCaddie at this time.
- * You can run the icon of FineCaddie EZ downloader on your desktop when FineCaddie is not connected to your computer.



② When FineCaddie is connected to your computer, model name will appear on screen of FineCaddie. Click on the [Start the update] button on the [FineCaddie Update] menu after connecting FineCaddie to your computer.



- ③ Update of Firmware and golf course data will be proceed.
- * The lead time of Update can differ depending on your computer specification and network condition.



④ Device will be rebooted automatically and update process is completed when you separate device from your computer during the [FineCaddie Update Complete] screen shown up.

- (5) Update will start automatically after separating FineCaddie.
 - * This screen only shows up when the firmware update occurs.



If FineCaddie booted normally, update process is completed.



- ® Device will be rebooted in 8 seconds after FineCaddie update completes.
 - * This screen only shows up when the firmware update occurs.
